Tentative Schedule

Saturday morning, 9:00 – 10:00

Mike's Favorite Contras – Some great contra dances offering variety and interest, with occasional reminders about points of style and timing that increase everyone's enjoyment.

Waltz Without Turns – For those who would like to add more non-turning variations to their waltzing.

Couples Massage – Join Tina as she shows some easy chair massages for couples.

Fiddle Workshop – Spend some time with Rex Blazer one of contra's great fiddlers! Intermediate/Advanced.

Saturday morning, 10:15 – 11:30

English Dances in Threes – All of these dances will have something to do with the number three, 3-couple dance, 3-facing 3 dance, a dance in three parts, a dance in 3/2 time, a dance in 3/4 time, a dance in 6/8 time.

Contras with Tom – Dance to some of Tom's favorite contras. You'll remember the good dances – not sure about the jokes.

Clogging for the Curious (beginner/intermediate) – Have you been thinking that clogging looks like fun and want to see what your feet can do? This workshop will get you to tap into the rhythm of the music and let your feet do their thing.

Beginning Fiddle – Learning to play the fiddle? Join us as we swap insights into playing the fiddle, play a few tunes and explore what makes a fiddle sound fiddly. Beginner/Intermediate.

Saturday afternoon, 1:30 – 2:30

International Dance – Come explore the music and dances of Eastern Europe and the Middle East. With a variety of rhythms, sounds, and tempos, this survey of international folk dancing will offer something for everyone at every energy level.

Dutch Crossing – Remember those shuffle-the-number magic squares? This is the dance equivalent! A unique and challenging dance - part Becket, part English and part Dutch(?) danced in an 8 couple square. Quadruple the fun!

Callers Workshop – Callers of all levels - improve your skills and experiment with new ideas. We will discuss effective teaching, walk-throughs, vocal skills, planning dance programs, collecting dances, being a dance leader and much more. Dancers are welcome to come just to listen & dance, or to participate.

Nature Walk – Take a relaxing walk as a staff member of the Outdoor Education Center guides us through the natural beauty around the camp.

Saturday afternoon, 2:45 – 3: 45

English Country Dance – Whether you are familiar with English dance or you haven't yet given it a try, come and enjoy the fun.

Community Inspired Contras – Ed brings some of his collected dances that grew from our communities.

Singing with Seth – Seth Houston brings songs that sparkle with lovely harmonies and groove with great rhythms. Songs drawing from African, Balkan, Appalachian, shape-note, and gospel music.

Yoga and Stretching – Come and unwind some of the contra kinks. Gentle and effective stretches to help the body come back into balance.

Saturday afternoon, 4:00– 5:00

Challenging Contras - Really cool contras with mind-boggling edges to challenge the most hardy dancers in the most delightful way. Enough twists to keep you on your toes!

Hoopercize – Back by popular demand - bring your hips and leave your dignity at the door! Karen Bell completes the circle of life – youthful play and great exercise! Bring your hoop or use hers.

Sunday Morning, 9:15 – 10:15

No Walk Thru & Medley – Maxi-dance. A great way to warm-up the dance day...better than a morning jog. Lots of music, no instruction, a few key tips so there's no catastrophic surprises. And did I say lots of music!

Contemporary English Country Dance – We'll be doing modern dances (Pat Shaw to the present) written in the historical English Country Dance style.

Contras from the Jane Austen Era – This class will feel like a combination of English and Scottish country dance, 19th century set dances, modern contras and waltz contras. Learn some of the typical figures and formations of these ancestors to our modern contra dances.
