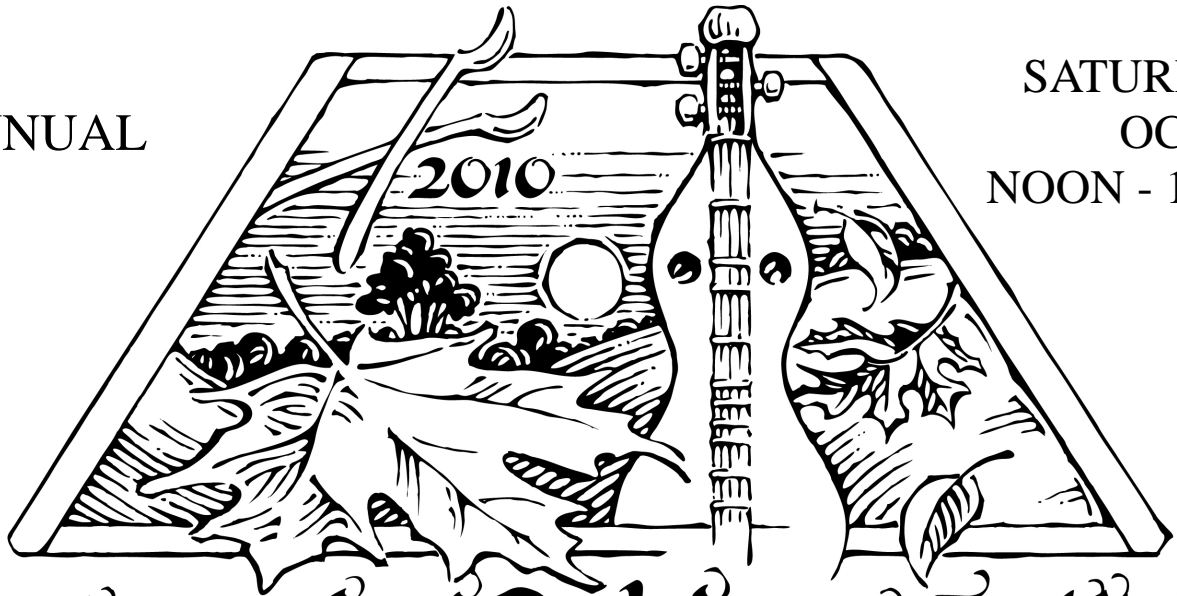

Madeline MacNeil is a best-selling author of mountain and hammered dulcimer books for Mel Bay Publications & has recorded numerous CDs over the years. Arts centers and universities throughout the United States have presented her in concert. Across the Atlantic she has performed at the O'Carolan Festival in Ireland; the Glasgow Festival of the Arts in Scotland; and for the Nonsuch Dulcimer Gathering in England.



Doug Berch is a folk musician, singer-songwriter, multi-instrumentalist and dulcimer maker. He is best known as a masterful player of both the mountain and hammered dulcimer. Doug has won both the mountain dulcimer championship and the hammered dulcimer championship at the Walnut Valley Festival in Winfield, Kansas.



Wanda Degen built her first mountain dulcimer in 1973, started teaching at Elderly Instruments in 1977, and still teaches there today. In honor of 30 years of teaching, she self-published two instruction books for the mountain dulcimer in 2007. Wanda is well-known at festivals all over Michigan for her family concerts and autoharp and dulcimer workshops.
